Tumalo School's Title 1A Team

The parent involvement team consists of volunteer Title parents, staff members and the Principal. Each fall the team will review and improve official Title documents. Tumalo School believes that student success is strengthened by family involvement in their child's school experience. Parents will be encouraged to volunteer in their child's classroom and to participate in school sponsored events.

Tumalo School Will Provide Parent Involvement Activities to Help Improve Student Achievement

Each fall the Title team will plan a special event to welcome parents and provide them with information about the reading curriculum, teaching programs, Title 1A reading interventions, and reading goals for each grade level. Parents will also complete a survey of needs to help inform the team on what parents need to help their children succeed. The results of this survey will help the team plan parent involvement activities that will help provide meaningful and varied opportunities for parents to be involved in supporting their child's academic achievement. When possible the team will help connect families with community outreach programs such as the Redmond Public Library, the Family Advocate Network, and other local agencies.

Tumalo School Will Help Improve Home to School Communications

The Tumalo Title 1A team realizes the importance of clear communication with families. It is our goal to provide written information that uses familiar language and is provided in the parents' native language. The team will also provide interpreters for major literacy events to help bolster the ability of non-English speaking parents to participate in their child's education.
